Send the right signals to your children by

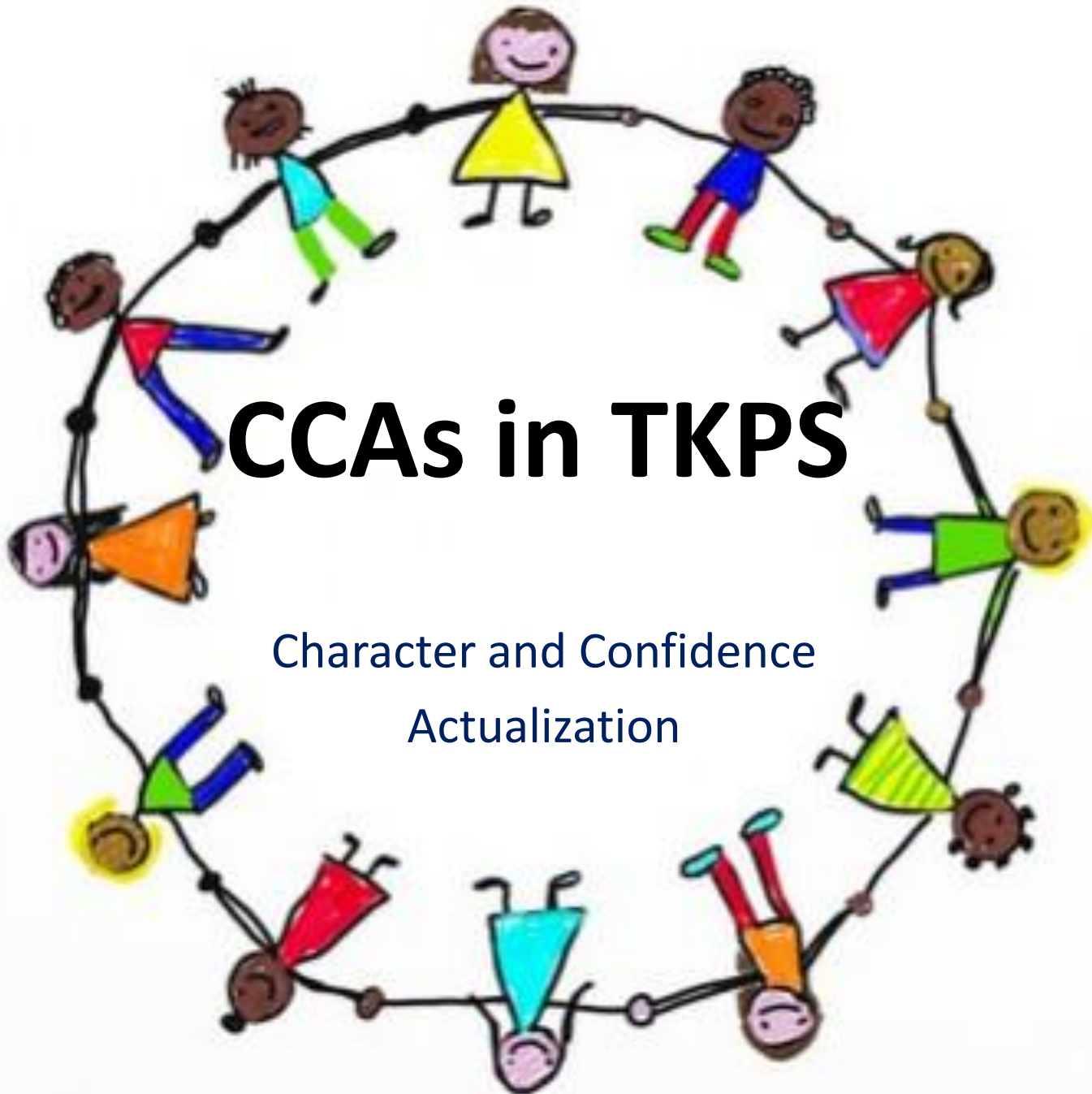
- Not missing lessons unnecessarily

What is CCA?

- **Co-Curriculum Activity** – a critical part of Holistic Education

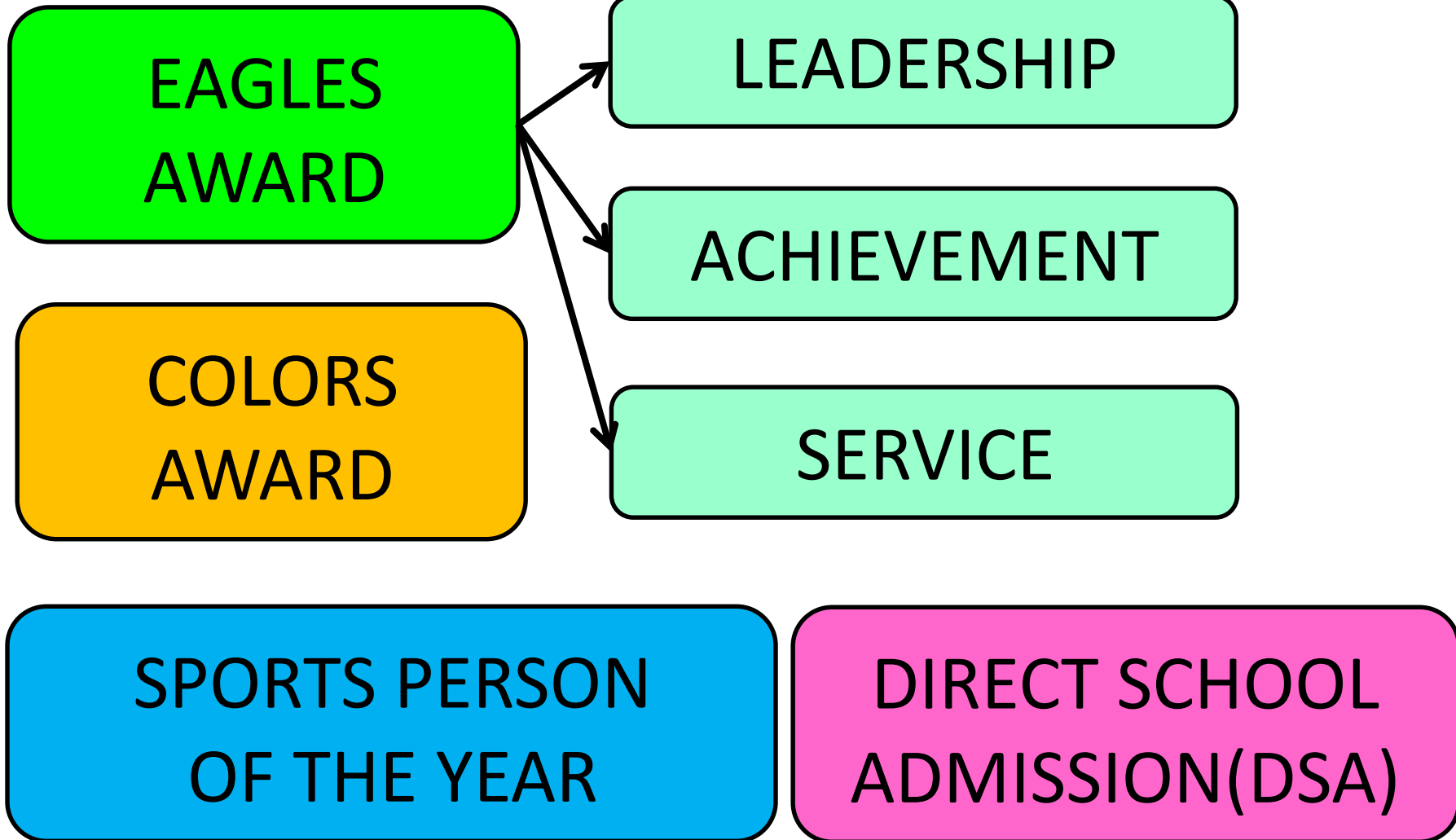

CCA Policy (Participation)

- Pupils can officially join CCAs from P3 onwards.
- P2 pupils can join CCA enrichment program from Term 3 onwards.
- All P3-P6 pupils are strongly encouraged to take up one CCA and continue with it for at least a year.

CCA Policy (2nd CCA)

- Pupils should take up a second CCA only if:
 - they keep good attendance records in their current CCA
 - parental permission has been given
 - there is vacancy in the CCA and the CCA OIC accepts the pupil
 - the two CCA timings do not clash
 - it does not negatively affect studies

**Approval of pupils taking up a 2nd CCA is given on a case by case basis.*

CCA Policy (3rd CCA)

- Pupils are **discouraged** from taking up three or more CCAs
