



SwimSafer is a national water safety programme in Singapore introduced in July 2010 by the National Water Safety Council (NWSC), a council appointed by the then Ministry of Community, Youth and Sports (MCYS).

SwimSafer aims to teach swimming proficiency and water survival skills to children to minimize drowning incidences.



At Telok Kurau Primary School, Swimsafer is offered to all Primary 3 pupils. For 2018, this programme will be carried out during the curriculum hours in term 1.
